IT IS PLANNED that *The Photogrammetric Record* will publish a special issue (or issues) in 2007–8, based on the theme of the ISPRS Hannover Workshop 2007 entitled "High Resolution Earth Imaging for Geospatial Information" and including peer reviewed papers based on the best presentations to the Workshop and additional papers which fit into the topic.

Authors interested to submit papers to this special issue are invited to consider the submission guidelines for contributions to *The Photogrammetric Record* (see *Hints to Authors*, 21(116): 424–427 in the December 2006 issue and subsequent issues, and also on the Remote Sensing and Photogrammetry Society website:

The Photogrammetric Record encourages authors to consider submitting an extended and/or modified version of the workshop paper for possible publication in the *Record*. Note that a submission cannot simply be a repeat of material already published on the workshop CD. The paper submitted to *The Photogrammetric Record* must explicitly cite the conference details and any published proceedings, an explanation of the difference between the workshop paper and the version offered to the *Record* should be given in an accompanying letter.

Contributions should be submitted to *The Photogrammetric Record* (photrec@rspso.org and also j.h.chandler@lboro.ac.uk) in the normal way, or alternatively to guest editors Christian Heipke (heipke@ipi.uni-hannover.de), Karsten Jacobsen (jacobsen@ipi.uni-hannover.de) and Jon Mills (j.p.mills@ncl.ac.uk), with a clear statement of the authors' intention and the paper's provenance in either case.

The deadline for submission of papers to the special issue is **October 31, 2007**.
